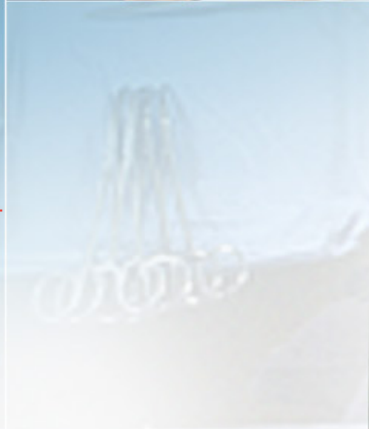

Dr. Mahesh Desai obtained his MBBS (1966) and M.S. in General Surgery (1970) from B.J. Medical College, Pune University. He received fellowship (FRCS) from the Royal College of Surgeons of London and Edinburgh in 1973. In U.K. he also obtained specialized training in Urology. In the year 1976, he joined hands with Dr. V.V. Desai and established the Muljibhai Patel Urological Hospital (MPUH) in a rural area Nadiad in the state of Gujarat in India.

He was the Chairman of the Department of Urology at Muljibhai Patel Urological Hospital from 1983 - 2010. He is the Managing Trustee of MPUH and Honorary Managing Director of Muljibhai Patel Society for Research in Nephro-Urology since 2001, Medical Director of MPUH since 2010 and the Director of the Jayaramdas Patel Academic Center.

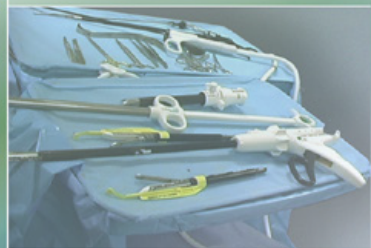
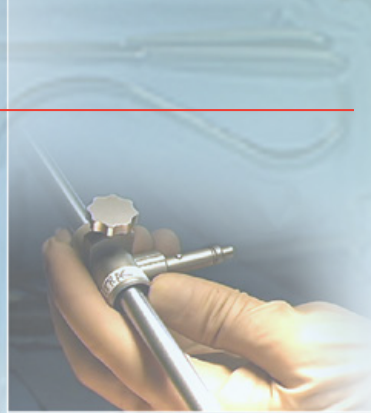
He has mastered the most modern treatment for the stone disease and developed innovative techniques in Percutaneous Nephrolithotripsy (PCNL), Ureteroscopy and ESWL. So far he has done more than 14000 PCNL, probably the largest series in the world. He expanded the use of ultrasound in Urology and established, for the first time, the service of kidney transplantation in Gujarat. In the year 1940 he did his first transplant.

The institute has produced 750 scientific papers. He has so far conducted 160 workshops, and published 140 scientific papers in national & international journals. His contributions based on academic and scientific activities have resulted in putting Muljibhai Patel Urological Hospital as one of the premier institutes in urology, not only in India but also Internationally. In recognition of its teaching program, Muljibhai Patel Urological Hospital gained recognition as a teaching Institute for postgraduate studies in Nephrology and Urology by the National Board of Examinations, New Delhi, since 1993.

He was awarded AUA prestigious Presidential Citation in 2012. He was also awarded the prestigious St. Paul's Medal in 2012 by British Association of Urological Surgeons.

Dr. Mahesh Desai's wide experience and skills have resulted in his being elected as a member of AAGUS. He is the first Indian to have this honor. He was also the first Indian to deliver a Guest Lecture in the plenary session at the AUA Annual Conference held in Chicago April 2003. He is on the Editorial Board of Journal of Endourology. Under his leadership India hosted, for the first time, the World Congress on Endourology, in 2004 in Mumbai.

He left his lucrative practice of 25 yrs. and decided to join full time academics for the betterment of the institute and the society. Under his guidance so far 68 courses in different fields of Urology have been conducted of which more than 4500 delegates have taken the benefit at the Jayaramdas Patel Academic Centre.
