Dr. Yves Fradet graduated from Laval University (Quebec, Canada) in 1981 and completed an oncology fellowship at the Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center, with Drs. Willet Whitmore and Lloyd Old. Since 1983, he has headed a research laboratory at the Laval University Cancer Research Centre in the university hospital, where he is also Director of the Urologic Oncology Section and the Urology Service.

He is a member of many national and international societies, including the American Association of Genitourinary Surgeons, and is often invited as a guest speaker at national and international meetings, as a visiting professor, and as a consultant to many organizations. He was the founding chairman of the Canadian Urologic Oncology Group from 1988 to 1995. He was the chairman of the Department of Surgery at Laval University from 2000 to 2008. He has authored over 315 publications and book chapters and 508 abstracts. Dr. Fradet is the recipient of numerous honours including life achievement awards from the Quebec Urological Association, Canadian Urological Association and the Société Internationale d'urologie as well as the Queen's Diamond Jubilee Medal from the Canadian Medical Association.

Dr. Fradet's research activities involve translational laboratory research in tumour immunology and molecular biology and the genetics of bladder and prostate cancer and their applications to new diagnostics and treatments, epidemiological studies in bladder and prostate cancers, and clinical trials in prostate cancer and other genitourinary cancers. He has a very active practice in urologic oncology, leading a group of six urooncologists at Laval University.
