Harry W. Herr received bachelor and medical degrees from the University of California, and his urology residency at the University of California at Irvine. He completed research and clinical Fellowships in Urologic Oncology at the Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center in New York. Dr. Herr has served on the Faculty at MSKCC for more than 30 years, where he is currently Attending Surgeon and Professor of Urology at Weill Cornell Medical College.

Dr. Herr is best known nationally and internationally for his work on bladder cancer. Notable contributions include BCG for superficial tumors, defining the natural history of urothelial neoplasms, introducing neoadjuvant chemotherapy for locally advanced cancer, evaluating the role of biomarkers, and most recently, optimizing quality of surgery for bladder cancer, specifically the role of transurethral resection and radical cystectomy with pelvic lymphadenectomy. He has published over 500 peer-reviewed scientific articles.

Dr. Herr is active in all of the major urology and oncology societies, including founding member of the Society of Urologic Oncology, American Association of Genito-Urinary Surgeons, and a 30-year member of the American Urological Association. Dr. Herr has mentored and trained more than 250 Fellows in Urologic Oncology, including many current and future leaders in urology.
