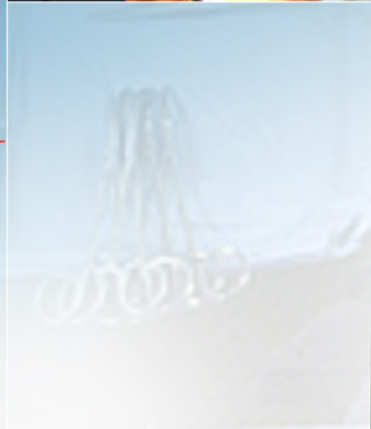

**Mitchell Humphreys MD** is an actively practicing consultant and Professor in the Department of Urology at Mayo Clinic in Arizona. He holds dual appointments in the Department of Urology in the Mayo College of Medicine and in Clinical and Translational Sciences in the Mayo Graduate School. In addition, he serves as the Associate Dean of the Mayo School of Continuous Professional Development as well as the Endourology Fellowship director.

Dr. Humphreys completed Medical School at the University of Missouri, Residency at Mayo Clinic in Rochester, and an Endourology and Advanced Robotics Fellowship at Indiana University. Since that time he has been on staff at Mayo Clinic in Arizona. His clinical focus is on surgical and metabolic stone disease, BPH (with a special focus on HoLEP), and minimally invasive GU oncology.

Dr. Humphreys has funded research initiatives in stone disease, BPH and NOTES radical prostatectomy. He is involved in several multi-institutional groups looking at population outcomes of urologic disease and new patient educational platforms.

In addition to the publication of over 70 peer-reviewed manuscripts and multiple book chapters, he is a journal editor and reviewer for several international urology journals. He has traveled extensively within the United States and internationally doing both surgical demonstrations and lectures in his areas of expertise.

Outside of his work with Mayo Clinic he is on the Board of Directors of GSD Healthcare, LLC promoting basic healthcare initiatives in underserved and impoverished areas around the globe. He also serves as a Board of Trustee member to Columbia College which attends to a student population of over 30,000 students.
